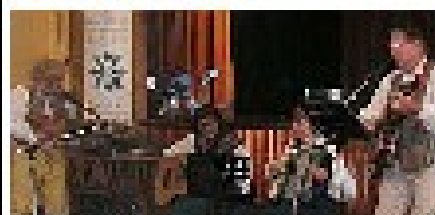
SOMETHING ELSE:

KUPALEJA:

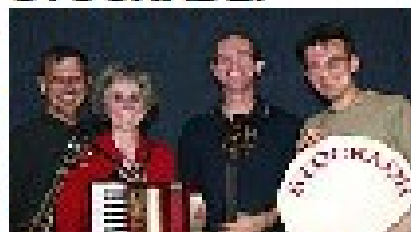


Brisbane based Scandinavian instrumental group. Members Kurt & Pat Christensen,
